For twenty years, Washington Improv Theater (WIT) has brought the art of improvised theater to the Greater Washington DC area. We help unleash the creativity of Washingtonians in every ward of the District.

We now serve thousands each year through 250+ performances, accessible eight-week classes, free introductory workshops a month (reaching every Ward of the District), as well as a number of other community outreach efforts including after-school programming at the Kingman Boys and Girls Club and Marie Reed Elementary School.

We are hosting a large fundraising event featuring a silent auction on May 16th at the Westminster Presbyterian Church. Our event is expected to draw over 200 attendees from the 23,000 annual audience members we have, which tend to skew toward young, social professionals.
