For over 25 years, Washington Improv Theater (WIT) has brought the art of improvised theater to the Greater Washington DC area. We help unleash the creativity of Washingtonians in every ward of the District.

We now serve thousands each year through 300+ performances, accessible eight-week classes, free introductory workshops a month (reaching every Ward of the District), as well as a number of other community outreach efforts including after-school programming at Project Create and work with veterans at the Armed Services Arts Partnership.

We are hosting a large fundraising event featuring a silent auction on May 3, 2024 at the Culture House in Southwest DC.
